

PINUPS & PUPPY DOGS

These pages are different than any coloring pages you've ever encountered.

The lines are intentionally broken or left out in spots. The reason for this is that we are mimicking oil paintings. Often in paintings, shadows merge from one form to another, and there is no clear distinction where one form ends and another begins. Solid line work would make achieving this effect impossible.

For these images, I recommend enlarging them to approximately 11 inches wide by 14 inches high, and printing them on 11"x17" Bristol Board or heavy card stock, and then trimming off the excess at the top and bottom.

Seriously, it's going to be tough on you at 8.5"x11" in places like the lips and eyes if you're using markers.
